Job Specs

Weight: 1075 Tons

Dimensions: 83'L x 65'W x 32'H

Equipment Used: 32 axle lines of SLE & 18 axle lines of ESE SPMT's, 30' barge ramps, 26' barge ramps, winch trucks, crane mats, water pumps and laminated mats.

The Team at Berard was at it again with the loadout of this Tahiti bound 1075 ton water injection module. The fifty axle lines of SPMT's tackled the job with ease as the load made it's way to the 260' x 72' x 16' deck barge. Once at the barge, the pre configured ballast plan was put into action and the loading went as smooth as planned. With the load now on the barge, it was lowered onto the specialized load supports and secured. Another day, another job, another success!



One Big Barge



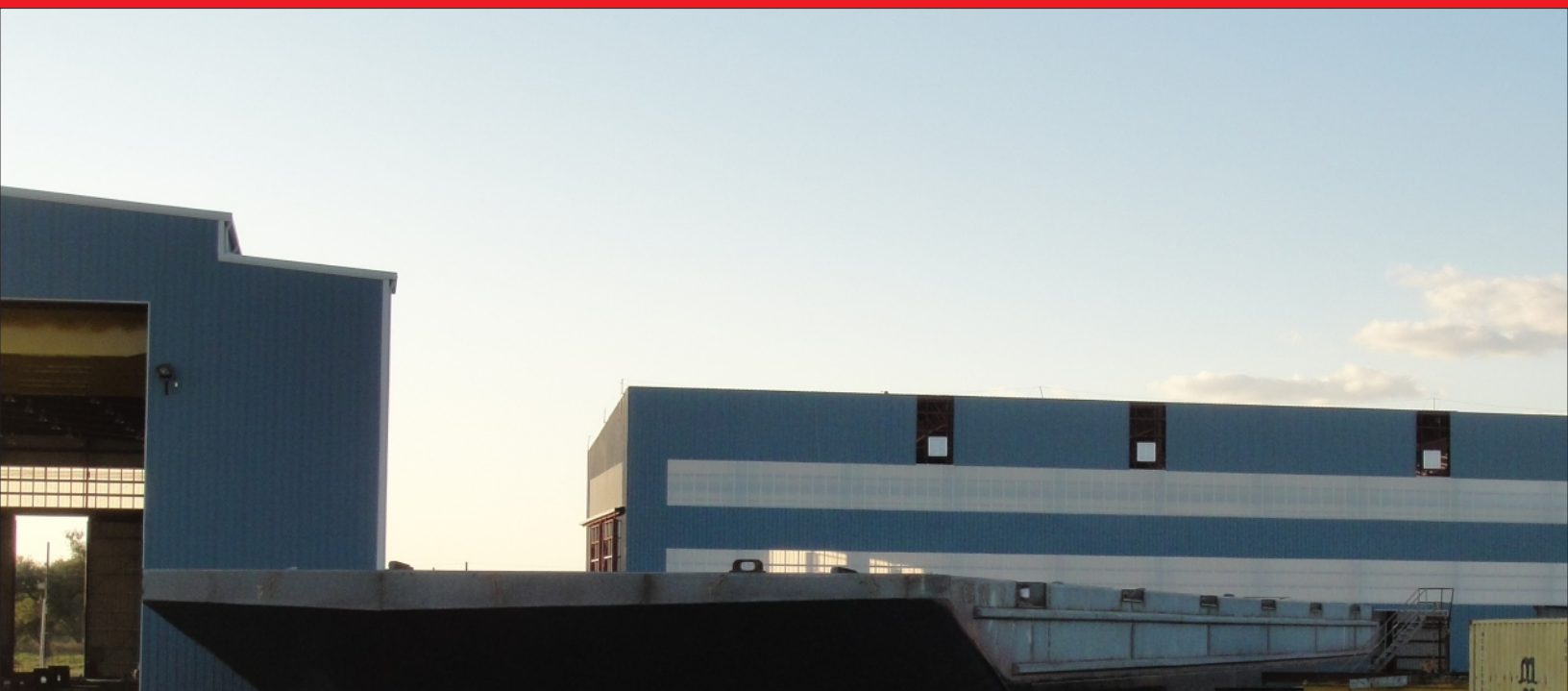
Job Specs

Weight: 1300 Tons

Dimensions: 260'L x 75'W x 16'H

Equipment Used: 52 axle lines of SLE SPMT's, 30' barge ramps, 2 winch trucks & crane mats.

One big barge is right, measuring 260' long, 75' wide and 16' high, this 1300 ton deck barge was quite the large cargo. The task at hand was transporting the massive barge to the clients drydock for launching, but getting it there required some great operating skills to maneuver the load around several buildings and other obstacles in the yard. At the end of the day the job was done safe, on time and with a happy client.

Weight: 140,000 lbs

Dimensions: 80'L x 15'W x 13'H

Equipment Used: Specialized Trail King 3 axle gooseneck trailer and 6 axle dolly configuration with turntable.

The team transported several of these modules ranging in weights and widths from the fabricators facility in Delcambre, Louisiana on our specialized trailer & dolly rig which was perfect for the job.
