# The Bottom Feeder Loadout



## Job Specs

**Weight:** 1300 Tons Each

**Dimensions:** 110'w x 128'h x 38'l

**Equipment Used:** 48 lines of ESE SPMT's, 3 ppus, loading ramps, steel plating & high volume water pumps

Looking like something from a sci-fi movie, these two 1300 ton bottom feeder "claws" were offloaded by the Berard Team in Sabine Pass, Texas. The claws are specially designed to salvage sunken oil and gas platforms from the bottom of the Gulf of Mexico. Berard used 48 axlelines of ESE's to offload them onto the clients yard where the team had to use steel plating to ensure that the soft ground conditions didn't hamper the move. The Berard Team has moved some pretty unique loads in it's history and this is definitely one of them. Congrats to everyone for working safe and accomplishing another job well done!





# The Coldbox Transport



## Job Specs

**Weight:** 128,000 lbs

**Dimensions:** 66'L x 17'-4"H

**Equipment Used:** 6 axle  
Goldhofer semi-trailer

This 128,000 pounds cold box may not be the biggest or heaviest transported by Berard, but of course all loads seem to have their own unique challenges. Due to delivery schedule requirements for this 66' long cold box, trucking instead of barging was the best option to deliver it from New Iberia to Sulphur, LA. Berard was able to tackle the challenge with ease due to the capabilities of their 6 axle Goldhofer semi-trailer. The cold box required support at 4 specific locations, making bolster dolly transport impossible. The extendable semi-trailer allowed for variable support at any point on the trailer, satisfying client demands. The low loading height of 33" allowed for a total load height of 17' 4", just low enough to traverse beneath railroad signals, bridges, and numerous oak trees. The load was safely delivered in less than 5 hours.
