Weight: 255 & 151 Tons

Dimensions:

BOP: 40'H x 16'W x 16'L

LMRP: 26'H x 16'W x 16'L

Equipment Used: 12 axlelines of ESE's, loading ramps, winch trucks and high volume water pumps.

The Team was on top of their game with the transport and loadout of these two very tall pieces. The LMRP and the BOP were fabricated in Berwick, Louisiana and needed to be loaded onto a deck barge for water transport to a waiting ship for final transport overseas. The towering loads had to be transported through a very tight and congested fabrication and assembly facility which proved to be a tight situation but nothing that our determined team members couldn't handle with the two six axleline SPMT's. The LMRP, the shorter of the two, was loaded first, then the BOP. The high volume water pumps made quick work of ballasting operations, making the loadout safe and timely. Once the two loads were in position, the team went right to work securing the load to the barge for it's voyage. 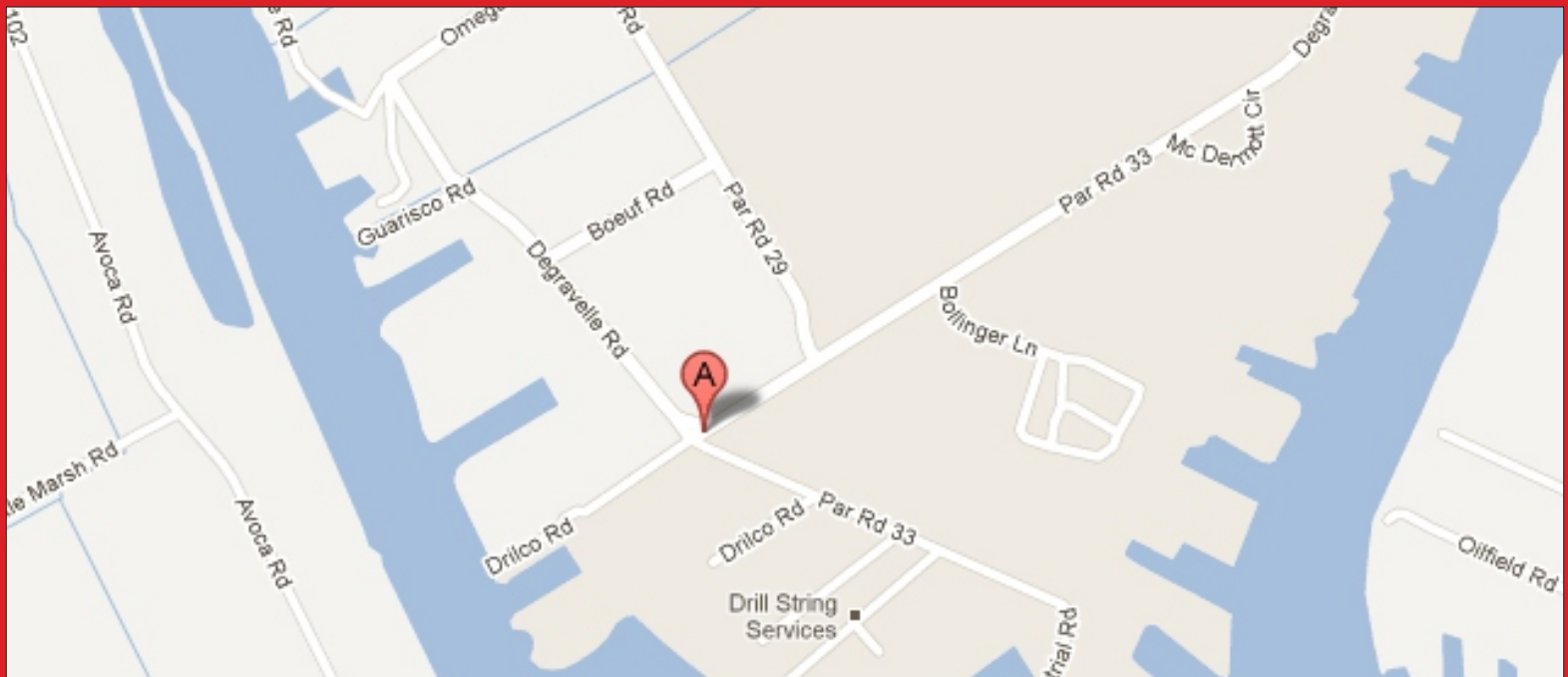


Berard Expands Again!

> Spotlight On Safety



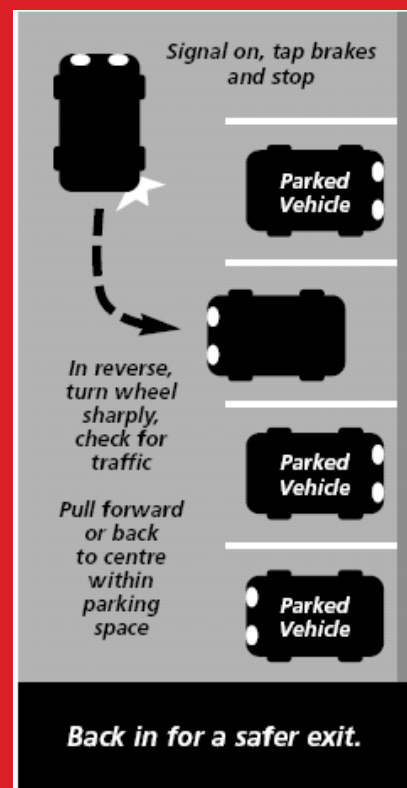
