This colossal behemoth was no match for the Berard Team which was commissioned to load the 4200 ton offshore jacket out for offshore delivery and installation. A staggering 196 axle lines of self propelled modular transporters were used to transport the jacket from the fabrication yard onto the deck barge where it was placed into final position and fastened for water transport to its final destination. The Berard Team worked closely with the client to ensure this job was done safely and in a timely manner meaning this jacket can get to work for its owners.
