Job Specs

Weight: 500,000 Lbs.

Dimensions:

75'L x 30'W x 46'H

Equipment Used: 12 axle lines of SPMTs, 2 power packs & steel plating

All hands on deck for this mega move.

The Berard Team transported this 500,000 lb. tugboat for a shipyard in South Louisiana. The team positioned 12 axle lines of SPMTs under the tug and used them to lift it off of its supports. Now ready for the big move, Berard's skilled team members began the slow transport of the tug through the fabrication yard, ever so vigilant to keep the high load level.

The transport had to travel through several tight spots as well as places where steel plating had to be used to support the weight of the tug and SPMTs. All went well and the mission was accomplished. Congrats to the team for a great job and a safe job!

Job Specs

Weight: 300 Tons

Equipment Used: 24 axle lines of Goldhofer SPMTs, beams, loading ramps, winch trucks and high volume water pumps

Berard was selected to transport five packages from the Port of Houston to a new plant in Beaumont, TX. With the largest vessel weighing over 300 tons, Berard put their team to work designing barging and roll-off plans at the final site. Using two barges and 24 axle lines of Goldhofer PST-SLE transporters, all cargo was delivered safely to the destination. Each barge was offloaded in only one day, much to the delight of the client who was eagerly awaiting their new refining equipment.
