Job Specs

Weight: 285 Tons Dimensions:

45'L x 34'W x 36'H

Equipment Used: 16 axle lines of SPMTs, 2 power packs, loading ramps, steel plate, water pumps and winch trucks.

This 285 ton module bound for the deep waters of the Gulf of Mexico was a cakewalk for the Berard Team. The module was transported on 16 axle lines of Scheuerle self propelled modular transporters from the fabrication site to a waiting deck barge. Ground conditions were unfavorable so the team laid steel plate to help distribute the load and ensure a smooth transport through the fabrication yard. Once at the bulkhead, the team slowly rolled the module onto the barge where the maneuverability of the SPMTs really shined in the final positioning of the module on to stands for its final voyage to the installation site.

6-axle Goldhofer PST-SLE, 300 ton slide system, 400 ton low profile slide system, jacks and unified jacking systems

Time to change out a transformer means time to call Berard. This old transformer at a substation in Arkansas was removed by the Berard team to make way to allow a new unit to take its place. The team mobilized to site, slid the old unit onto a 6-line SPMT, moved it to a dismantling area, and jacked it down. The new unit was then received from a rail car one mile away, slid onto the SPMT and transported to site and then finally set on the pad. On the job was our new 400 ton Hydra-Slide low-profile skidding system. All components of this system can be handled by hand, reducing assembly and disassembly time in congested areas.
