The story began over 9 years ago when a dedicated group of volunteers, many of them veterans, embarked on a restoration project to restore the PT 305. The team spent countless hours working tirelessly on the craft to bring her to her former glory. The boat was restored in the WWII Museum in New Orleans, Louisiana, and will be housed on Lake Pontchartrain. When her restoration was complete, Berard got the call to move her from the WWII Museum through the streets of New Orleans to the Mississippi River where she was lifted onto a barge for transport to a shipyard where the final outfitting will take place before hitting the water once again. The move was quite the spectacle with hundreds of spectators and news outlets from around the nation walking beside her in a true New Orleans style parade.
