The 361' Barge Launch



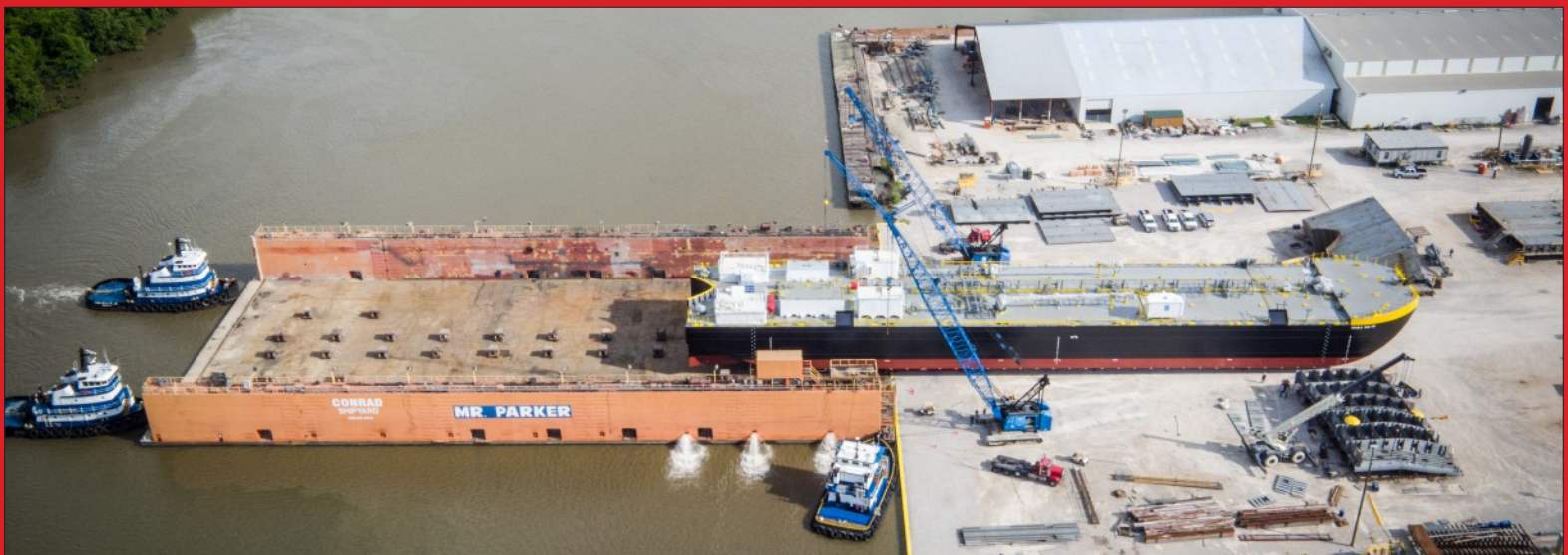
Job Specs

Weight: 2,270 Tons

Dimensions: 361' L x 61' W

Equipment Used: 84 axle lines of SPMTs, 4 power packs, loading ramps, steel plate and winch trucks.

Back to the shipyard for the Berard Team. The team was commissioned to load out this enormous 2,270 ton, 361' L x 31' W tank barge in South Louisiana using 84 axle lines of SPMTs. Steel plate was laid down in some areas to support the massive load as it traveled to the client's dry dock. As the load moved onto the dry dock, high volume water pumps went into action, making the transition from ground to dry dock a smooth one. This was an impressive project but what the team admired was the positive attitude on the entire yard. Positive people make a great project even greater! Equipment Used:

12 axle line THP Trailer, 9 axle Hydraulic Trailer, 12 lines of SPMT, ballast pumps, barge ramps

Berard was recently tasked with transporting two skids to a land based oilfield site near Monroe, LA. Berard first rolled the skids onto a barge in New Iberia, LA. The barge then traveled via inland waterways to a roll-off site on the Ouachita River near Columbia, LA. Despite record flooding in the area, Berard developed a safe roll-off plan. The modules were then moved 70 miles to the final destination.
