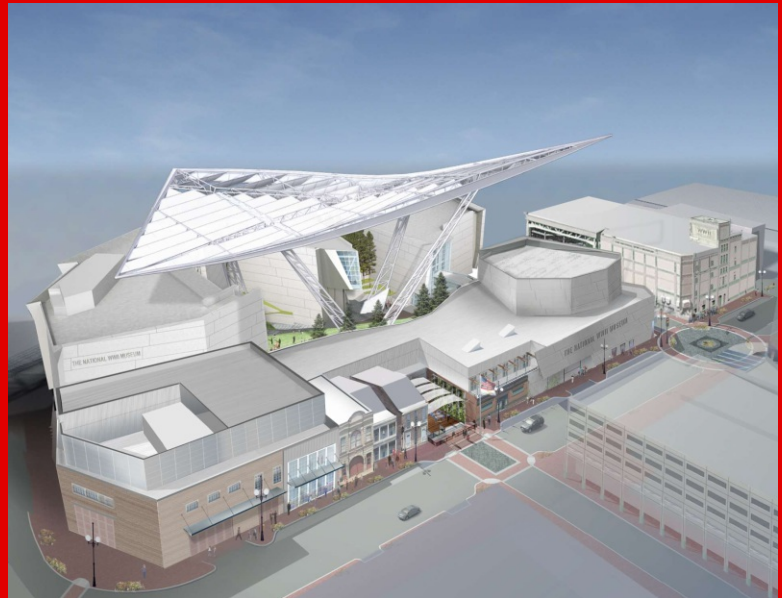
Berard transported this 125' vessel from northern Mississippi to a refinery near New Orleans, LA using a hybrid trailer configuration – a Trail King 6 axle dolly system along with a Goldhofer 6 axle STZ trailer were the perfect combination to obtain permissible axle weights while maintaining a simplistic transport design. Berard performed a lengthy route analysis to ensure the vessel could travel the 530 mile route to the destination, which was traveled in 4 days for delivery.



WWII Museum Canopy of Peace Project



A new skyline changing project for the National WWII Museum was the perfect challenge for Berard. The Canopy of Peace project involved transporting 14 truss sections from the Port of New Orleans to the congested downtown area of the project. The largest and widest cargo ever moved by Berard from the Port of New Orleans by road was no challenge for the team. Moving at night with 2 pieces traveling together, the Berard team made each move in less than 2 hours. We are proud to be part of this project for the National WWII Museum, and can't wait to see the finished product.
