The Berard team has been hard at work with a 2 year project transporting and loading out modules destined for a major plant project in Pennsylvania. A local fabricator has been assembling the modules at their Louisiana facility and Berard has been there from the beginning helping to ensure that the project stays on it's demanding schedule. Modules of various sizes and weights required the team to utilize several SPMT configurations to make sure the modules were evenly supported as they were lifted, transported and loaded onto deck barges. The project has been smooth sailing thanks to the planning of Berard engineers and boots on the ground getting the job done safely and on time.
