



Equipment Used:40 axle lines of SPMTs, 4 power packs, loading ramps & winch trucks

The team recently loaded out this massive 220' long x 100' wide dry dock for a local South Louisiana shipyard. The team maneuvered the dry dock from it's fabrication area to the dry dock for launching. The move began with the team rotating the cargo between shop supports and other obstacles in the yard to line up with dry dock. It was a tight fit but the team made it happen. The dry dock was then rolled forward onto the larger dry dock and set down onto supports for launching at a later date.

The Berard team transported a skywalk bridge section for a Jacksonville, Florida hospital expansion project recently. The skywalk was constructed on a nearby street and when it was ready for installation, Berard crews went to work setting 12 axle lines of SPMTs under the structure to ready it for transport the next day. The Saturday move brought with it some great weather for the event in which many of the patients from a nearby children's hospital watched the walkway move down the street. The team made an immediate right turn off of the original construction site/street and headed towards the installation site where two Liebherr cranes lifted the walkway from Berard's SPMTs and rotated it 90 degrees into position onto the supports. Berard was glad to help our heroes get easier future access to their facilities.
