# The Shipyard Dry Dock Offload



## Job Specs

**Weight:** 1,849 Tons

**Dimensions:**  
320'L x 105'W

**Equipment Used:**  
64 axle lines of SPMTs, 4  
power packs, loading ramps  
& winch trucks

The team recently offloaded this 1,849 ton dry dock for a south Louisiana shipyard client. The dry dock measuring in at 320 feet in length and 105 feet in width was transported utilizing 64 axle lines of SPMTs powered by 4 power packs. Berard team members carefully lifted the dry dock from its supports and rolled off onto 26 foot barge ramps to make the transition from dry dock to ground. The team then transported the behemoth cargo to the final location in the client's yard where it was precisely positioned and lowered onto supports. Another successful project completed safely by our great team members!
