

110'L x 30'W x 66'H

Equipment Used: 36 axle lines of SPMTs, 2 power packs, deck spacers, weighing system, loading ramps, high volume water pumps and winches for barge securement


The Berard team loaded out several module packages for a local fabricator. Berard provided a turnkey service to the client which included weighing each module with our certified weighing system. The fabrication yard was filled with modules under construction which made for maneuvering the massive 446 ton loads through quite a few obstacles along their journey to the bulkhead. The team used 32 axle lines along with deck spacers to accommodate the 100' length and distribute the load evenly across the SPMTs. Both modules were loaded onto the deck barge and set down in their final position for the water transit portion of the trip. Thanks to our team for making another great load out!












The Berard team moved a 250,000 lb. boiler to a New Orleans area refinery in 1999, and again in 2020 when it reached the end of its lifespan.
