The Shipyard Dry Dock Load Out

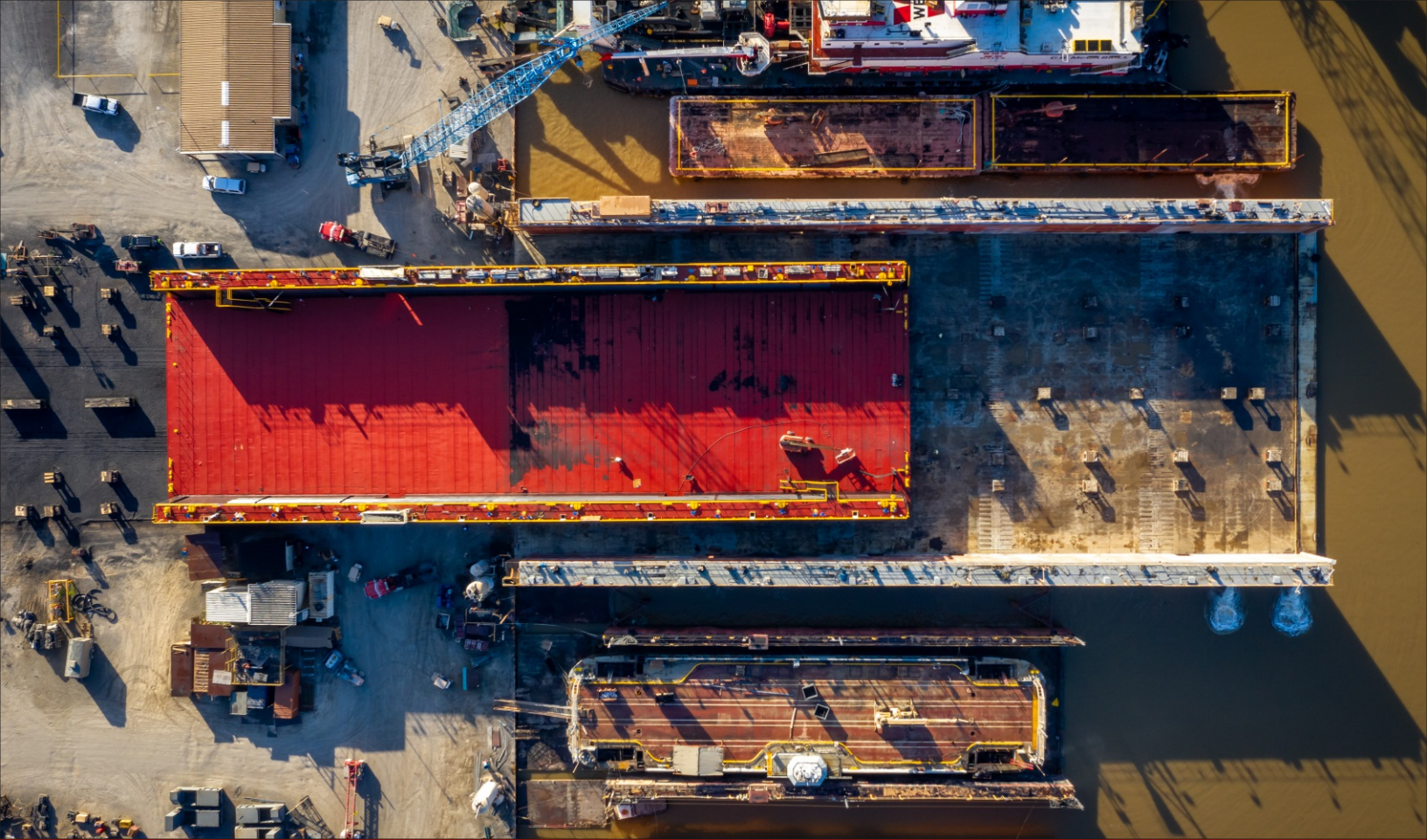

In our May 2020 issue, we featured this 1,849-ton dry dock offload for a south Louisiana shipyard client. The dry dock was refurbished by the shipyard and was now ready for load out. The dry dock measured 320 feet in length, 105 feet in width, and was transported utilizing 64 axle lines of SPMTs powered by 4 power packs. Berard team members lifted the dry dock from its supports and rolled it onto the shipyard's dry dock, and precisely positioned and lowered it onto supports. The Berard team was commissioned to transport a total of 18 vessels from the Port of Houston City Docks to a Houston area refinery. Berard engineers and project managers worked closely with TXDMV as well as the cities of Galena Park, and Baytown, Texas for city transport permits. The project spanned about a year in length with the team helping to ensure that all of the tight deadlines and schedules were kept on track. The team utilized an array of specialized transport equipment to accommodate the various types of loads. All cargo was delivered on time, and within budget, making for a very satisfied client.
