The team headed to the great state of Texas to transport a 134,000 lb electrical transformer from China, TX to Cleveland, TX. That amount of cargo weight called for our 13 axle steerable lowboy trailer to handle not only the weight, but to make the route's tight turns more manageable, thus making better time during transport. The team dealt with rain showers throughout the trip but pressed on in a safe manner to get the cargo delivered. Once at the final location, the team had to maneuver the cargo and the entire 134' length of the rig into a tight left turn into the substation. The project was a success, thanks to our awesome team members who make it happen on every project!

Berard was contracted to move (10) 60,000 gallon LP storage tanks from manufacturers in Oklahoma & Mississippi to the site in Houston, TX. With limited space and construction at the site restricting the ability to receive all (10) units at the same time, Berard offered a solution to self-unload and store at our Houston facility until the site was ready to crane offload and set (5) units at a time. Berard project managers handled the coordination to align delivery with pick up and transport through multiple states and the schedule of the onsite crane supplier to keep the client's project on schedule and in budget.
