

lines of SPMTs, 6 power packs, 2 deck spacers, loading ramps, 18 high volume water pumps, 425' x 126' x 25' deck barge, 65 ton winches and tugs The Berard Team was proud to load out the Navy's newest addition to its fleet, USS Augusta—a 418'L x 107'W Littoral Combat Ship (LCS). This marks the 29th ship that Berard has launched for the client. Berard accomplished the load out & transfer using 112 axle lines of SPMTs. The team rolled the 2,800 ton LCS from the final assembly bay to a waiting deck barge on time and keeping the project on schedule. The LCS was then barged down river for trans-loading from deck barge to dry dock. The entire process was accomplished in only one day and most importantly, safely. Our team did a great job and we thank them and everyone involved for another successful project!
