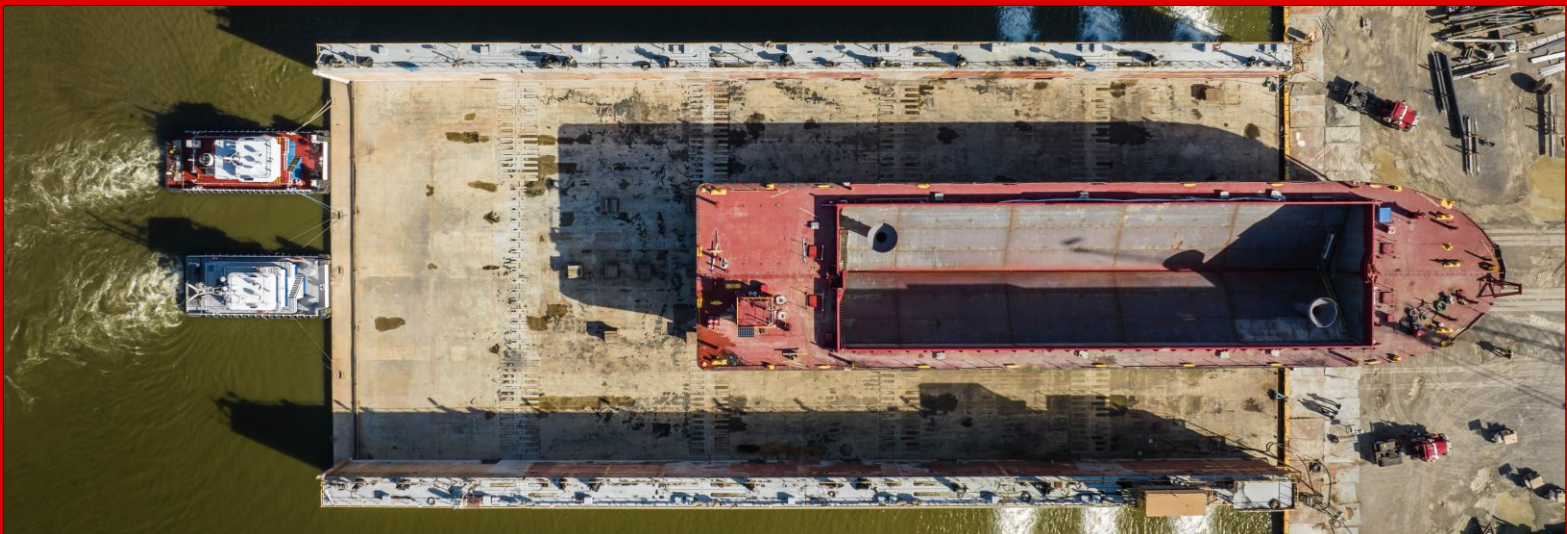

Berard recently loaded out this massive 1,671 ton scow barge for a major shipyard located in South Louisiana. The 277' long x 64' wide barge was lifted from its supports at the fabrication area and was then maneuvered through some pretty tight spaces in the fabrication yard to get to the client's dry dock. It was a slow and steady trip to the bulkhead where the team prepared for loading. Ballasting operations commenced and the team began the loading process working closely with the dry dock operator to ensure a safe and timely loading of the cargo. The Berard team moved the barge into its final position and lowered it onto pre-positioned supports. Both Berard and the client's team worked together to make this project just another day at the office. Congrats to all on this great project!

The Berard team is no stranger to the oil and gas sector, having performed load outs and off loads spanning over 60 years. Fabricators across the country know that Berard can get the job done on time and most of all, safely. This was one such fabricator in Ingleside, Texas, who commissioned Berard to load out an offshore package consisting of a 900 ton jacket and 551 ton deck. The team utilized 64 axle lines of SPMTs to transport the behemoth 900 ton jacket to the bulkhead and rolled it onto the deck barge. Next up was the 551 ton deck. The team used 40 axle lines of SPMTs to bring the cargo to the bulkhead to be loaded onto a separate deck barge. The team loaded it out in fine fashion and set it down into final position where it would be sea fastened for its future voyage and installation in the Gulf of Mexico. The Berard team once again completed this project through the hard work and dedication of our team members who make it happen day in and day out. Thanks team!
