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# On The Road 300,000 lb. Column Transport

The Berard team accepted the challenge of transporting a 300,000 lb. column from a fabricator in Mississippi to a Houston, Texas area refinery. Berard engineers and project managers determined the vessel could be shipped via road or barge, thus feasibility was studied and deemed possible for both options. During the study, the Berard team obtained full permit clearance for the full gross weight of the transport rig at 640,000 pounds from Mississippi, Arkansas, Louisiana, and Texas, thus the decision was made to ship the column via truck to expedite delivery. Using 12 axle lines of Faymonville DualMAX platform trailer powered by two Kenworth C-500 prime movers, the load was delivered along the 725 mile route in 5 travel days.

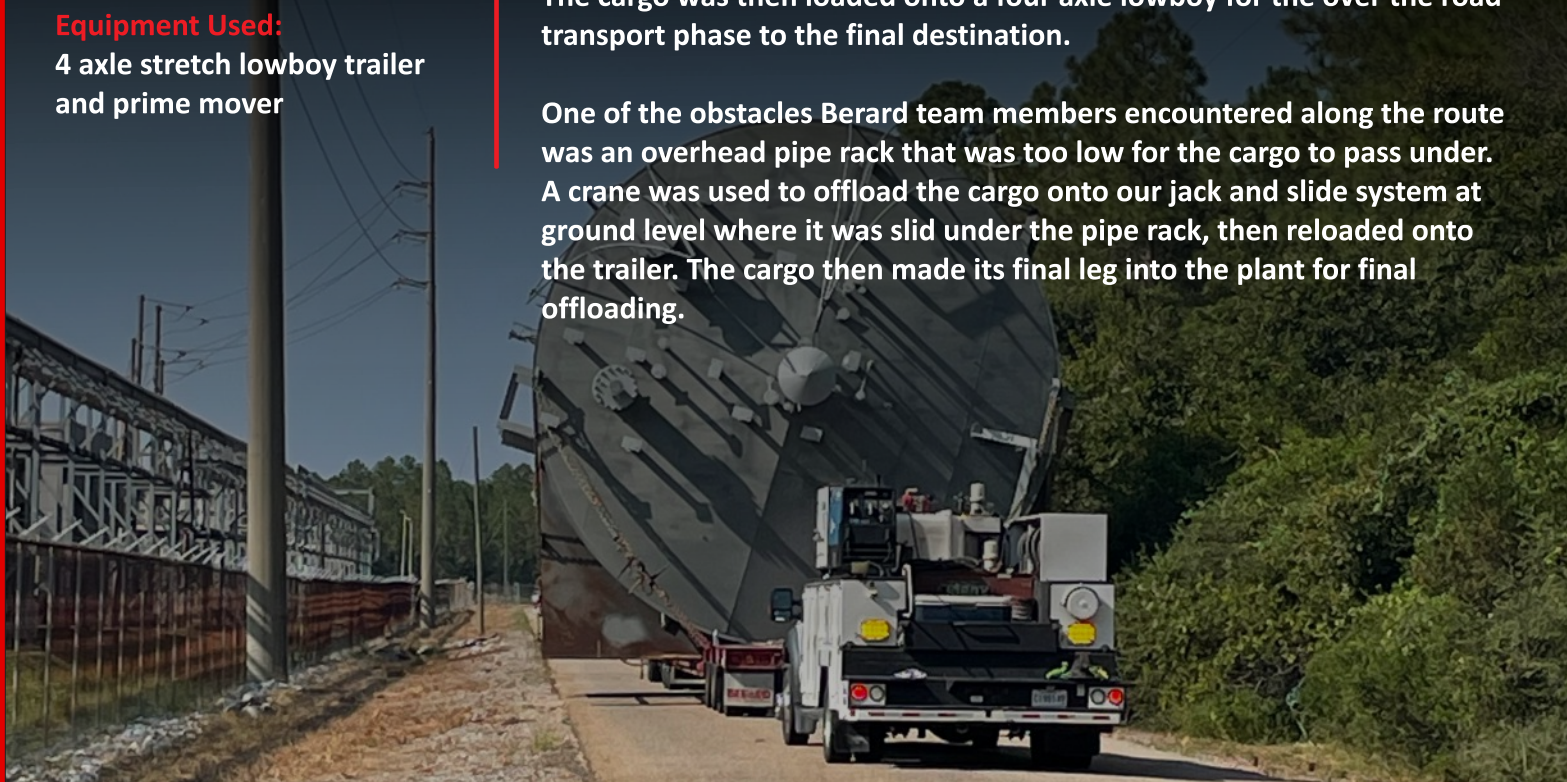

While we've been known to transport some of the largest and heaviest cargo, we've also had our share of smaller oversized transports. This is one such case where Berard provided a turnkey transport solution to the client. The team transported a sulfur tank from Moss Point, Mississippi, to Theodore, Alabama. The Berard team provided marine transport and crane services for loading in Moss Point and the offloading in Theodore. The cargo was then loaded onto a four axle lowboy for the over the road transport phase to the final destination.

One of the obstacles Berard team members encountered along the route was an overhead pipe rack that was too low for the cargo to pass under. A crane was used to offload the cargo onto our jack and slide system at ground level where it was slid under the pipe rack, then reloaded onto the trailer. The cargo then made its final leg into the plant for final offloading.
