# The Shipyard Barge Load Out



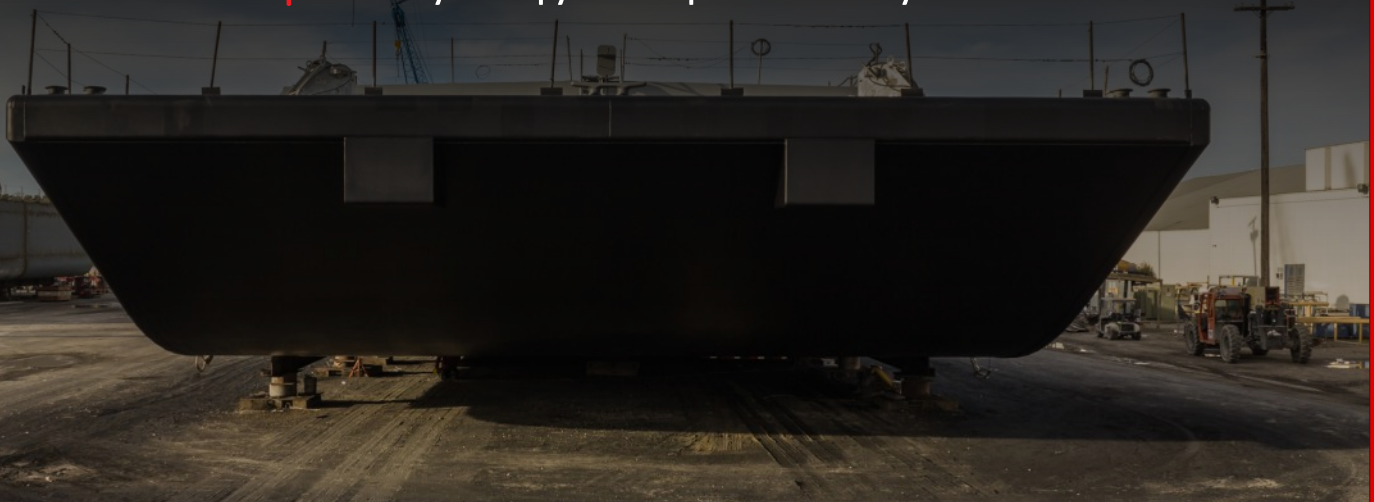

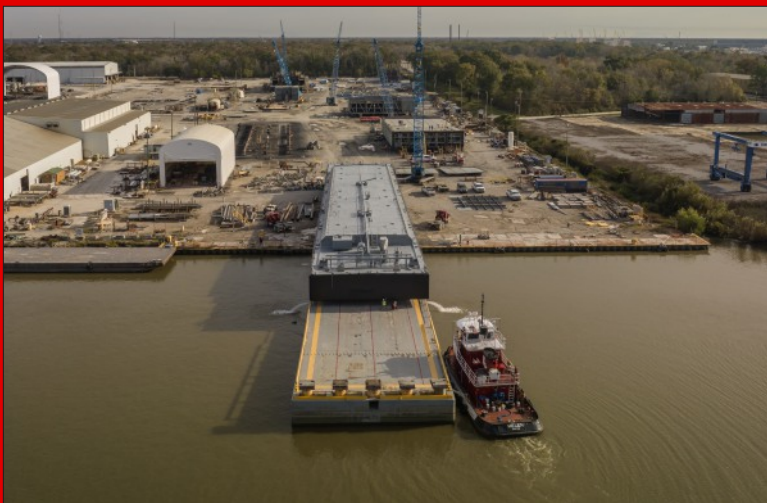

Another shipyard, another successful project completion for the Berard team. Shipyards rely on Berard to help them stay on schedule and our team delivers. This 199' barge was built at a major shipyard in south Louisiana and needed to be launched as it was at the completion stage of the build. The team used 32 axle lines of self-propelled modular transporters to move the 870-ton, 199' x 55' barge from the fabrication area to the bulkhead for loading onto the client's dry dock. The team navigated the massive cargo around several builds in progress in the yard. Once at the bulkhead, Berard worked closely with the dry dock ballast control operators to ensure a safe and timely roll-on operation. The team completed the project by lowering the barge onto pre-positioned supports. Helping clients with heavy transport solutions that keep schedules running smoothly is what we strive for at Berard. 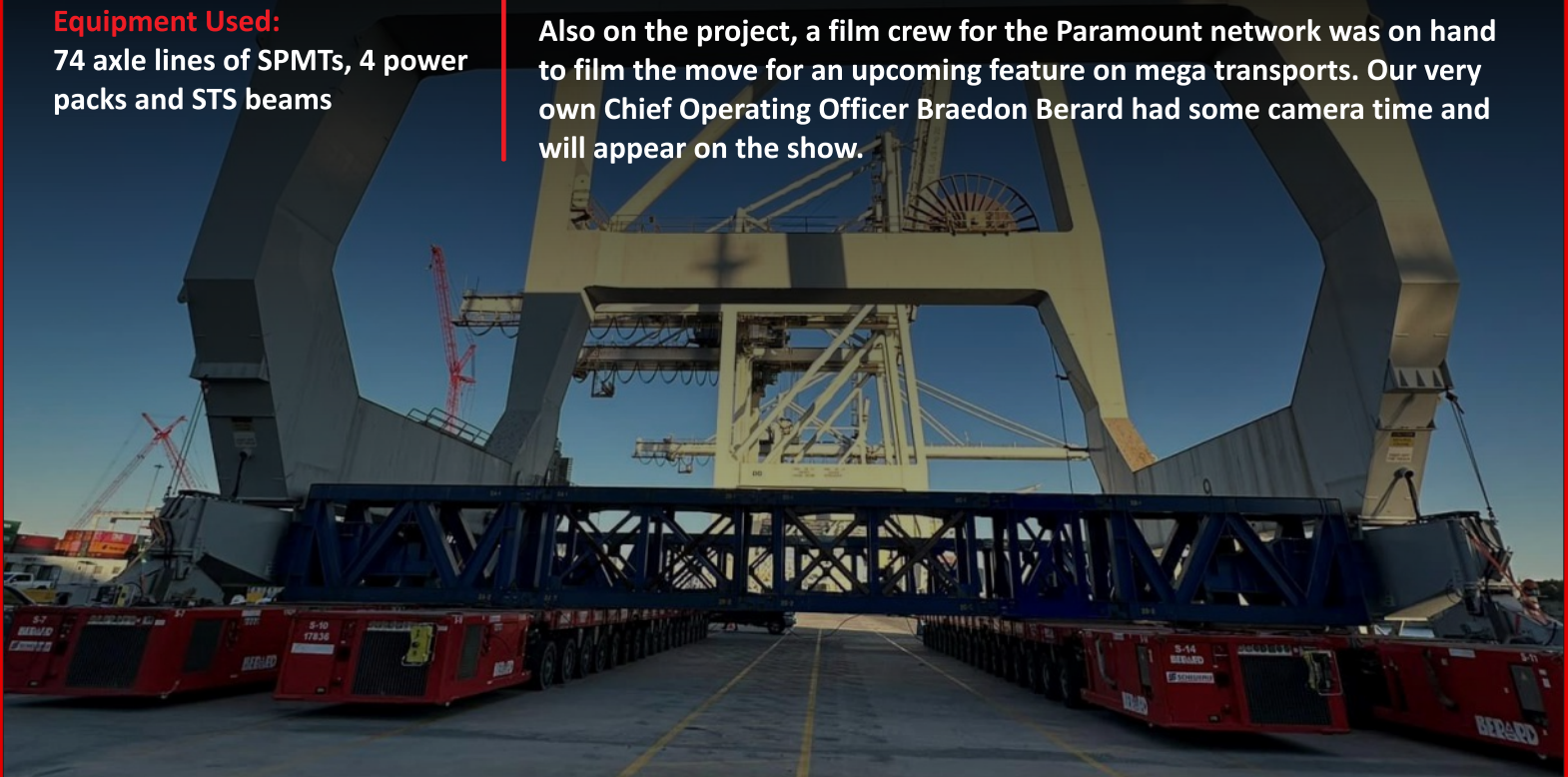

The Berard team traveled to the great state of Georgia to move 3 STS cranes for the Port of Savannah. The cranes were being de-commissioned and have been replaced with updated cranes to serve the port's busy traffic. The team utilized 74 axle lines of SPMTs and STS support beams to move the massive cranes from the rail to a staging area nearby for dismantling. Berard completed all three cranes within 5 days.

Also on the project, a film crew for the Paramount network was on hand to film the move for an upcoming feature on mega transports. Our very own Chief Operating Officer Braedon Berard had some camera time and will appear on the show.
