
The Berard Modular Beam System (MBS) keeps another port STS crane project on schedule. The team traveled to Jacksonville, Florida to put the finishing touches on a STS crane refurbishment project at JaxPort. The MBS system can be tailored to accommodate many rail gauge widths, proving to be quite the valuable and versatile asset. Our team setup the system in a short amount of time and was ready to make a quick transport to get the 1,110 ton STS crane back to rail and back in service. The crane was lifted and transported from the refurbishment area and onto the main pier on 72 axle lines of SPMTs. The crane was then rotated and moved into position then aligned with the rails and lowered. This was another success story for our MBS System.


