





On The East Coast 2 STS Cranes @ JaxPort







The Berard team recently completed two more STS crane transports at the Port of Jacksonville, Florida. The team got an early start and was setup and ready to move the first crane at daylight. Our MBS - Modular Beam System proved itself once again as a very valuable asset for making crane moves much quicker due to its design for rapid deployment and quick setup time. Once port crews disconnected the umbilical cable, Berard was ready to start the move of the first crane to a specified location off rail. Both cranes were transported on 72 axle lines of SPMTs, setup in a four file configuration. At the final location Berard lowered the crane onto temporary rails and securement procedures commenced. The team then setup under the second crane and transported it on the same travel path as the first and placed into final position. Both the MBS system and our dedicated team made quick work of this project.





Load Out 2 Cold Boxes Loaded Out @ Port Of Iberia







The Berard team is no stranger to projects at the Port of Iberia. We've been doing projects there since the 1960's and it's located in our backyard. The team was commissioned for a longtime client to load out two cold boxes weighing 932,800 lbs each. Berard utilized 20 axle lines of SPMTs to lift and transport the boxes from the fabrication area to the bulkhead for loading onto a deck barge. The SPMTs made navigating the client's yard an easy process. Once at the bulkhead the team rolled onto the barge and set down into their places and once the SPMTs were removed, sea fastening work began. Our team once again made quick work of the project, ensuring the client's build schedule remained on track.
